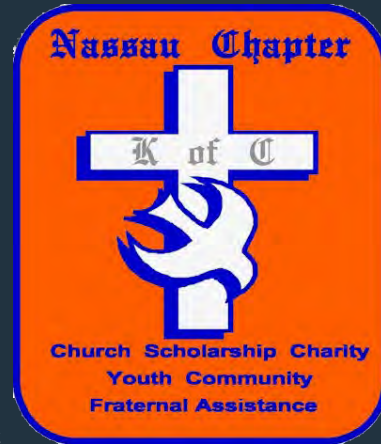

2024 C&B PROGRAM

Based on feedback from many areas and the fact that the convention will be in May, we are launching this years' program earlier than we have in the past. A summary of the program is listed below which includes some added bonuses this year. This will give councils an opportunity to take advantage of spring activities in their local areas. ie street fairs, carnivals, etc.

Rich Valenti the Nassau Minor Co-ordinator will be distributing books at the April 19 Chapter Meeting. He also has details on Comedy Night and C&B Bowl. We ask Grand Knights to begin setting up their calendars for their areas for book sales.

The Quick Start drawing is July 21 at the Villa Roma so this gives sellers the best opportunity to win. We ask any outgoing Grand Knight to get the ball going and not leave it for the next one coming in.

In 2023 Nassau increased their Sales from 9,606 in 2022 to 10,136 in 2023 and hit .85 books per member.

Our goal is 1 per book, Brothers we are close to hitting it in Nassau!! Let us this year reach back and hit the target we know is achievable.

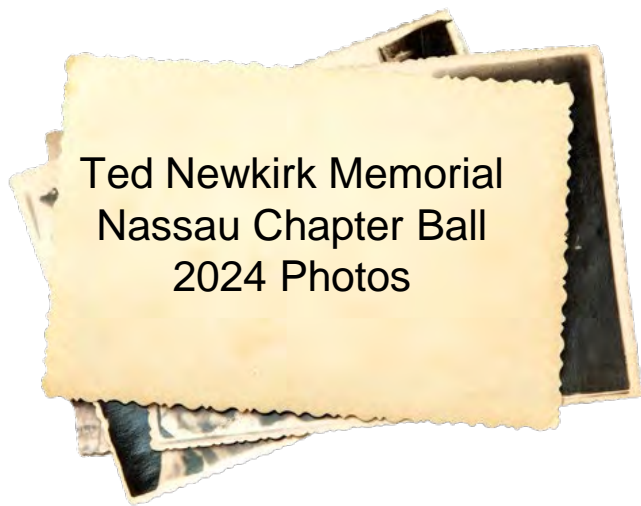

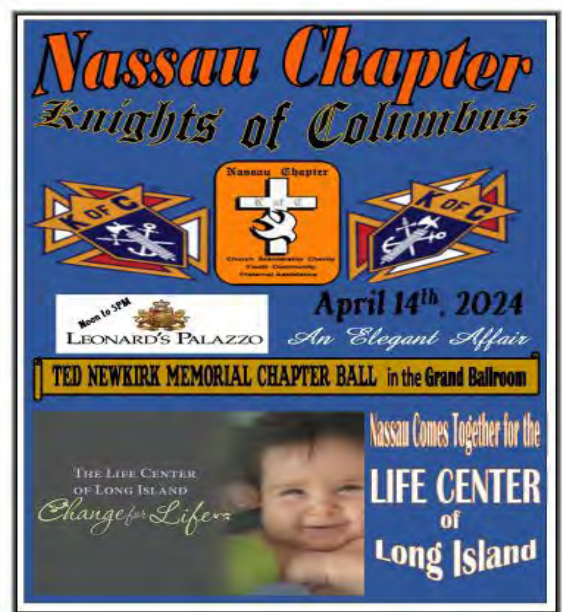

Nassau Chapter Blood Drive Chair Report

This year is the 10 year during which I have had the pleasure of chairing the Nassau Chapter's Blood Drive Committee. The Committee keeps track of the number of lifesaving pints of blood that are donated through blood drives that are sponsored by Councils in Nassau County and also acknowledges blood donated by individual Knights at established blood collection sites in the County. The Chapter recognizes these generous Knights and Councils by awarding a plaque to the Council which has organized the most pints of blood during the preceding Columbian year.

Over the last nine years, the Knights in our Chapter have been responsible for the collection of 23,600 pints of blood. Not surprisingly, the amount of blood collected during the years of the pandemic were decreased, as there were fewer organized blood drives. We collect an average of 55-60 pints for each drive that is held, so the annual number is a reflection of the number of drives that we are able to organize each year. This year, we have collected 2182 pints year to date, only 100 pints less than the last pre-COVID year at the same time.

There have been a few outstanding Councils over the years. Floral Park Council, by partnering with the community and their Fire Department and by identifying a worthy cause for their drives, has been the perennial leader in collecting the most blood. Holy Family Council collected 101 pints in their February drive. And, in their first ever blood drive, San Patricio Council collected 99 pints in March of this year.

Want to take a crack at winning the award for collections this year? All you have to do is organize one or two extra drives each year. If your Council has never held a blood drive, designate a member to chair a committee for your Council and have them contact the New York Blood Center at (516) 478-5026 or (516) 478-5006, and the very personable managers of Business Development will give you all the information you need to help you set up a blood drive date and location.

We will be following the same requirements set forth by Supreme Council with a few changes. Every council who gives \$500 to an individual seminarian or religious aspirant instead of a refund to the council, the NY State Council will support the seminarian or religious aspirant with \$100 sent directly to the council's recipient. The maximum refund a recipient can receive is \$400 per individual supported.

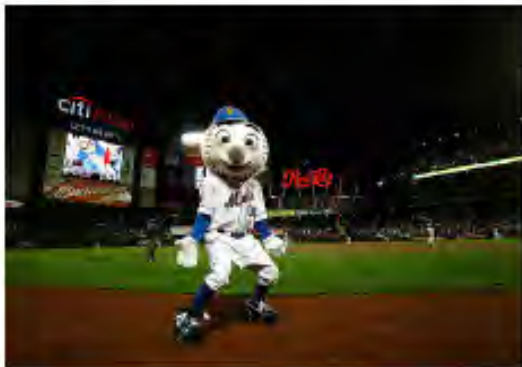

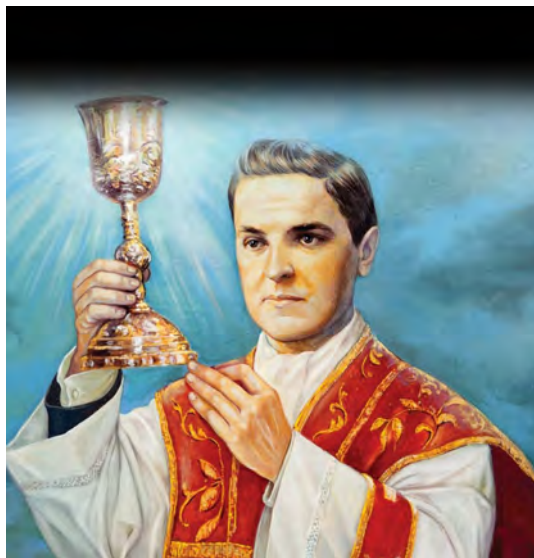
FRATERNITY CENTERING BROTHERHOOD ON CHRIST

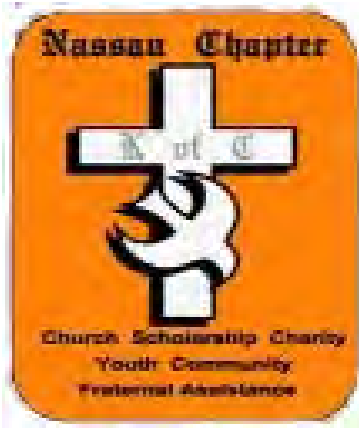


Prayer for the Canonization of Blessed Michael McGivney
